Verification of statements of support: IT aspects

- The verification process went smoothly from an IT perspective.
- 3 online bilateral meetings were organised to support 3 Member States facing local and specific challenges.
- This shows the importance of starting the verification process as soon as possible so that any problems can be tackled early, giving enough time to the Member State to finish the verification process within 3 months.

Reminders on verification of supports by MSs

1) Personal data transferred are different between eIDs and online form.

- **Online form or paper form.** Annex III of the ECI Regulation:

- Part A) **First name, last name, date of birth, address**

- Part B) **First name, last name, document type, document number**

- **eIDAS**

- **First name, last name, date of birth, unique eIDAS identifier (Nationality not included in the eIDAS data set. Needs to be checked by Member States)**

2) MS verification - check duplicates between online, paper and eID supports.



% eID Support vs total number of supports




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Supports using eIDs – trend per MS

Objectives

We call on the European Commission to foster equitable, timely, affordable, safe, and legal access to innovative psychedelic-assisted therapies.

1. The Commission should support the establishment of an expert consensus on standards of psychedelic care, with psychological support, therapist training, ethical guidelines and safety measures, to ensure the safe and effective rollout of psychedelic therapies. The Commission should back capacity building efforts for multidisciplinary training programs on mental health, specifically designed for psychedelic therapy training for healthcare providers.
2. The Commission should boost EU-funded research into the therapeutic applications of psychedelics to strengthen the evidence of their safety and efficacy. It should support the development of research networks focusing on innovative therapies.
3. The Commission should adopt common positions within UN fora to advocate for pragmatic, progressive transnational regulations concerning psychedelic compounds, and make appropriate recommendations for the rescheduling of psychedelic compounds in the 1971 UN Convention on Psychotropic Substances.



- If the initiative obtains at least one million signatures (and minimum numbers in at least seven Member States), its organisers will ask national authorities to verify the validity of the signatures.
- If the verification process confirms that the thresholds are reached, the organisers can ask the Commission to reply to the initiative.
- The Commission will have to reply within 6 months, indicating the action it will take, if any.


