



Step 1: Preparation

Now:

7 EU citizens old enough to votein EP elections living in at least7 different EU Member States

As of 2020:

- ✓ Possibility for organisers to set up a legal entity
- ✓ Intensified assistance and information: online collaborative platform; national contact points...

Step 2: Registration

Now:

The Commission checks the legal basis of the request and decides if to register or not (takes 2 months)

As of 2020:

- ✓ Two-stage procedure allowing organisers to revise their proposal (+ 2 months)
- ✓ Partial registration
- ✓ Free translation in all EU languages

Step 3: Collection

Now:

The organisers have **12 months** to collect **1 million** statements of support (on paper or online)

As of 2020:

- 2 options/sets of data (instead of 13 now)
- ✓ All EU citizens can take part regardless of their place of residence
- Lowering of the age of support to 16 (if Member States so decide)
- ✓ Flexible **start date within 6 months** of registration
- **Central online collection system** provided by the EC for free
- Individual online collection systems possible for initiatives registered until end 2022 only

Step 4: Verification

Now:

National authorities check the validity of statements of support before organisers can submit the initiative to the EC (3 months)



- ✓ Deadline of **3 months** for organisers to submit statements of support for verification
- ✓ Verification facilitated by IT tools (file exchange service)

Step 5: Examination

Now:

The organisers get a meeting at the EC and hearing in the EP and the EC comes out with an official response on actions to take, if any (3 months)

■ As of 2020:

- ✓ Deadline of 3 months after the end of verification stage to submit a successful initiative
- Extension of the examination phase (6 months)
- ✓ More inclusive consultation

Citizens' committee! Group of organisers

Setting up of a group of minimum 7 organisers residing in 7 different Member States

Registration

Registration of the initiative with the Commission which verifies, inter alia, that the proposal does not fall manifestly outside its competences

Collection

Callection of statements of support in paper form and/or online

Verification

Verification of statements of support by competent national authorities

Examination

Meeting with
Commission,
public hearing in
the Parliament
and final response
of the Commission
