6 new initiatives started using the E.C. COCS

- *Protect the EU's Rural Heritage, Food Security and Supply*
- *CALL TO ACHIEVE A TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT AND THE FIRST EUROPEAN TOBACCO-FREE GENERATION BY 2030*
- *European Citizens' Initiative for VEGAN MEAL*

No initiative started using their own Individual OCS

Since 01/01/2023, COCS is the only collection system allowed to collect supports under the ECI regulation.

Submission to Member States for validation

Initiative “Fur Free Europe” used the File Exchange Service to submit their online supports to Member States for validation:

- registered under ECI Regulation 2019/788
- Individual online collection system
- submitted on 13th March 2023 – Deadline for issuing Annex VI on **13th June 2023**.
- 15 Member States have already issued their Annex VI (on 03/06/2023)

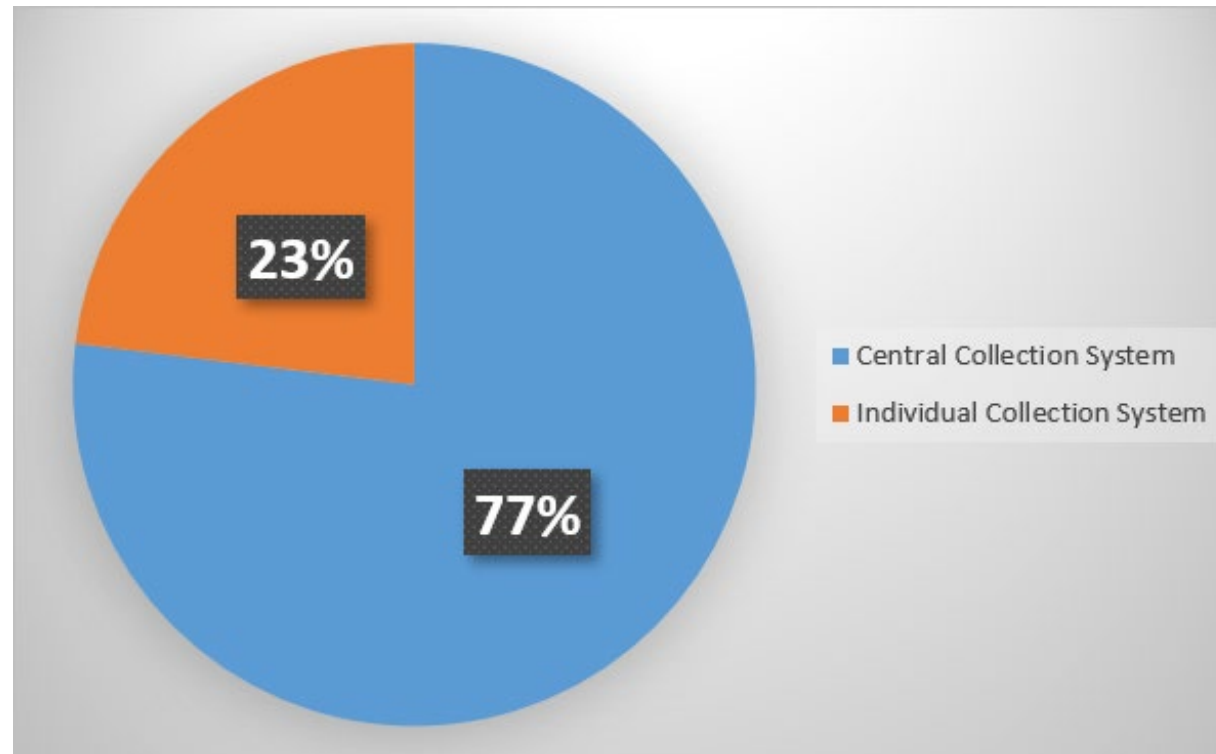

No other initiatives currently plan to Submit to Member State

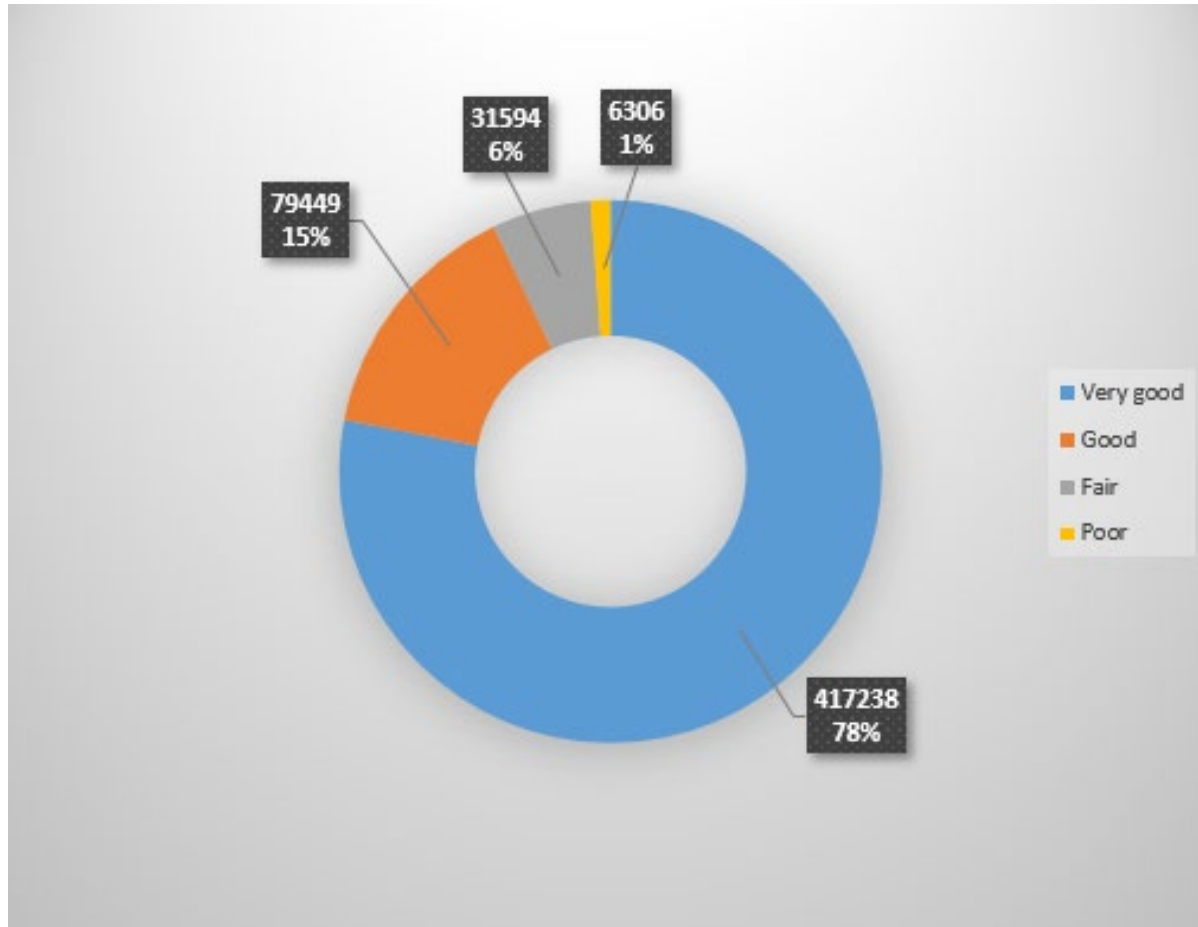
% of initiatives using COCS vs IOCS

Between 01/01/2020 and 31/12/2022:

- 20 initiatives out of 26 chose the Central Collection System
- 6 initiatives out of 26 chose the Individual Collection System

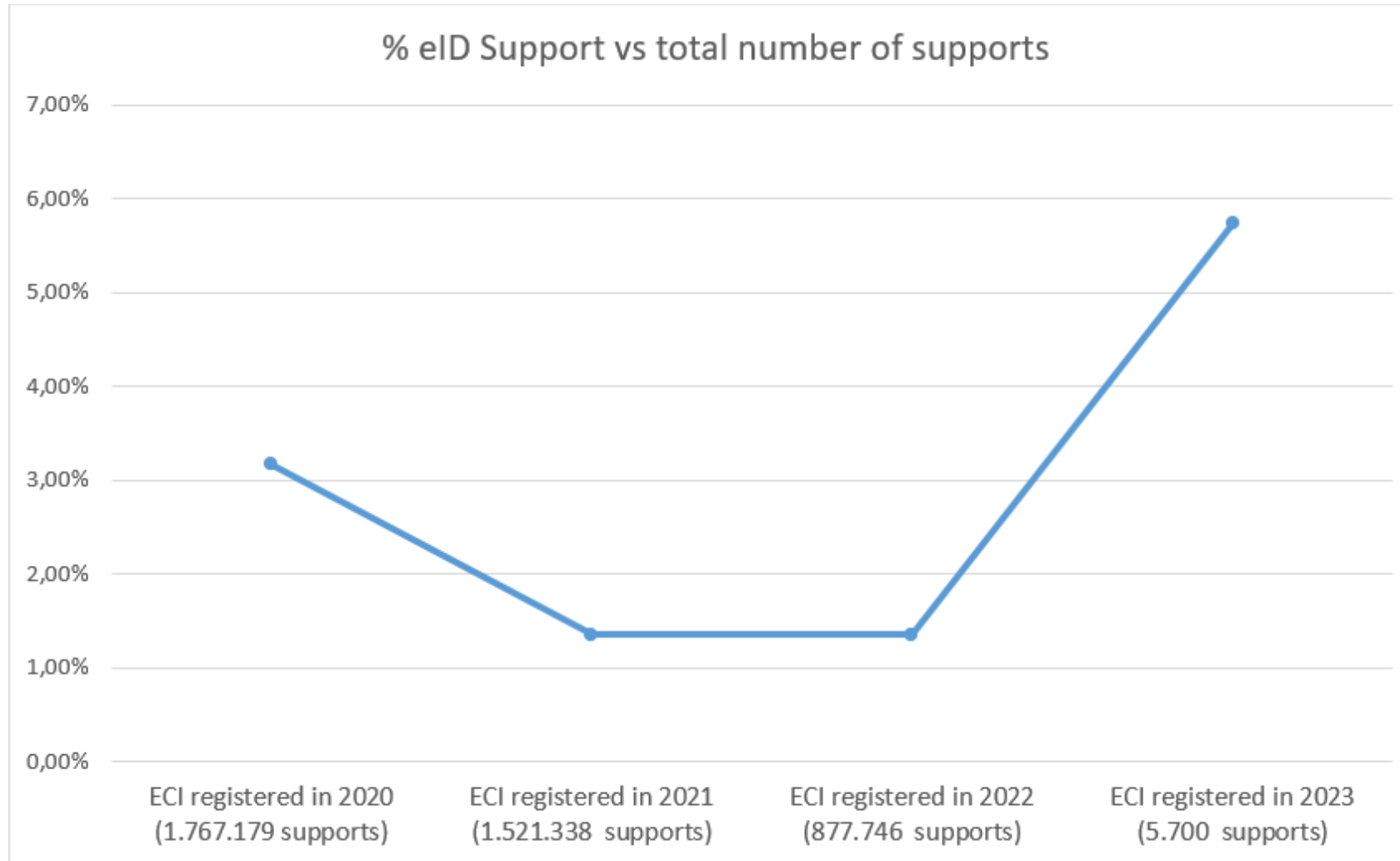

Integration with EU login

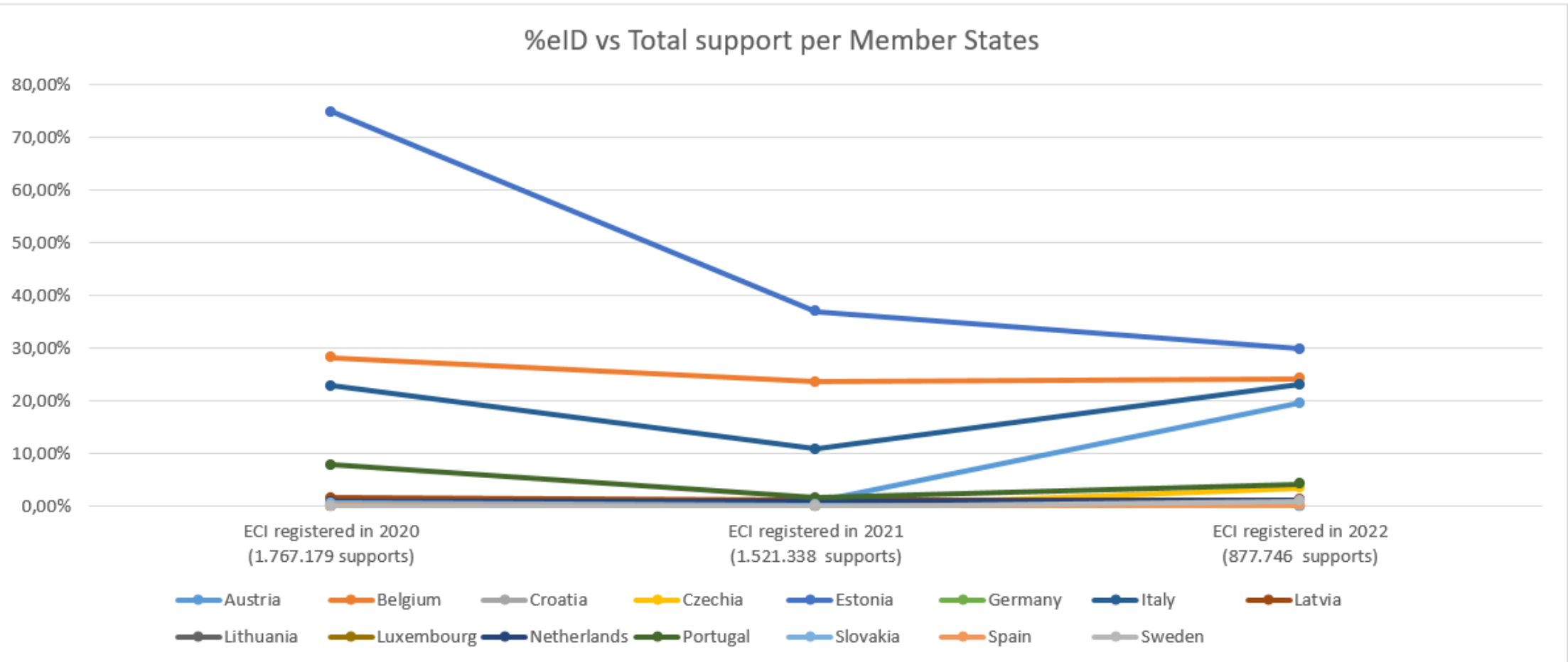
DK integrated in the EU login acceptance environment
